Private car travel opportunity

Cruising by Rail will be taking the private car Diablo Canyon to Los Angeles for some maintenance work to be done at the Amtrak facility. When the work is completed we will travel to San Diego. The plan calls for departure from Tucson at approximately 11:30 PM Saturday May 22 with arrival in Los Angeles around 8:30 AM Sunday morning. We have requested that the car be serviced and then taken to the shop. If all goes well we will take the early morning train on Monday to San Diego staying overnight and returning to Los Angeles Tuesday evening with an 8:20 PM departure. We will depart Los Angeles on Wednesday afternoon on Amtrak train number 2 at 2:30 PM arriving Tucson around 1:00 AM.

The major purpose of the trip is to complete the maintenance and we will be handled by Amtrak after their equipment is serviced. You may get off the car at the depot in Los Angeles and rejoin us at any time. The location of the car will be available via cell phone. The trip time to San Diego is variable based on our time out of the shop but you will be kept up to date if the schedule changes.

Transportation to and from your boarding point will be your responsibility. We will pick up passengers at any Amtrak stop between Tucson and Los Angeles. Final arrangements are dependent on Amtrak and the number of folks who decide to travel with us. We are awaiting their response. In the end, the schedule may vary slightly but the substance of the trip will remain. The schedule is as follows:

Meal service will include breakfast, lunch and dinner while the train is enroute Tucson to and from Los Angeles and Los Angeles – San Diego. While parked in Los Angeles and San Diego a continental breakfast will be available, no other meals will be provided on board. Beverage service including beer, house wines, soda and water are included and will be available. Beverages are not permitted on the station platform and must not be taken off the cars. Amtrak has improved performance greatly but our return schedule is very often late. Be prepared.
