

## LOS ANGELES EXCURSION

The Arizona Railway Museum is planning an excursion to Los Angeles, California this spring. This is a low cost trip for museum members and supporters of the museum. The time frame we are looking at is the middle of March.

The planned route is that of the Amtrak Sunset Limited. This train travels via Casa Grande, Maricopa, Yuma, Palm Springs and Los Angeles. Scheduled departure time from Tucson is 9:30 P.M. With arrival in Los Angeles at 8:05 A.M. On the return trip departure from Los Angeles is scheduled for 10:30 P.M. and arrival in Tucson at 8:30 A..M.

Transportation to and from Tucson prior to departure and after return will be your responsibility. The U.P. yard office has a parking lot that is safe, though not secure. If you are going on the trip more details will be provided.

Final arrangements are dependent on Amtrak and the number of folks who decide to travel with us. We are awaiting their response. In the end, the schedule may vary slightly but the substance of the trip will remain. The schedule is as follows:

Sunday	5-02	Depart Los Angeles in PM – Day Free
Monday	5-03	Arrive Tucson

- \* If our dining car is still in Los Angeles I will arrange a trip to visit it. More will follow to those who sign up for the trip.

### DESCRIPTION OF ACCOMMODATIONS

Travel will be on board the “VISTA CANYON” and the “JANE MARIE”. The “VISTA CANYON” was built for the Santa Fe Railroad as a bedroom - lounge - observation for their premier train the Super Chief. All accommodations will be in drawing rooms. Each drawing room has three beds, private toilet and sink. The car is equipped with a public shower. The lounge area has very comfortable seating in chairs and has two tables for snacking or card playing . Each drawing room has a couch and chair. The “JANE MARIE” is a private car with 2 bedrooms sleeping 2 in each room. This car has a large lounge seating 12 comfortably. You will have access to both cars. Vestibule riding with open upper door is permitted. We will have 3 vestibules available and will ask you to share.

Meal service will include continental breakfast and light supper while the train is enroute to and from Los Angeles. While parked in Los Angeles a continental breakfast will be available, no other meals will be provided on board. Beverage service including beer, house wines, soda and water are included and will be available in both cars. Breakfast and supper will be served buffet style. This is a low cost trip. You will be responsible for your own room . There will be no porter service to make up the beds. Beverages are not permitted on the station platform and must not be taken off the cars.

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

### INCLUSIONS

All meals on-board enroute. Soft drinks, bottled water and, in moderation, beer, house wine

### EXCLUSIONS

Airfare to/from boarding and detraining points, and airport to train transfers. Personal expenses. Accident, baggage, cancellation insurance. Gratuities to train staff. Off-train expenses.

### INSURANCE

### RESERVATIONS

A deposit of 25% must accompany all reservations. Full payment must be made by April 1, 2003.

### CANCELLATIONS

Cancellation fee of 25% if canceled more than thirty (30) days before departure. No refund if canceled thirty (30) days or less before departure.

### SMOKING

Permitted only in the vestibules. No smoking inside the cars.

### TIPPING

Gratuities received are pooled amongst the service staff. Average gratuity is \$15.00 per day per passenger.
